## WASTE DISPOSAL TENURE AT STANLEY ROAD

Reference is made to your letter in which you ask for this Council's consideration on the following:

1. The Shire's long term commitment to waste disposal at Stanley Road Waste Management Facility.
2. The Shire's preferred model of ownership of the Stanley Road Site. (Two Member Council joint ownership or BHRC ownership).

It is my view, that the Stanley Road Waste Facility would be the preferred option for future waste disposal for the Shire of Harvey. It is envisaged that the Shire's Richardson Road site will become a transfer station for general/putrescible waste to be disposed of at Stanley Road, but will continue accepting inert waste and recyclable materials. There is however no specific timeframe for this change but as a guideline, within the next 5 years is anticipated, depending on future waste directions. Any future changes concerning this will require Council approval.

The current arrangement of disposing of all kerbside waste collected within the Shire will continue to utilise the Stanley Road site. This however would again be subject to future waste direction that may be dictated by the State Government.

On point two, at this stage I cannot give any certainty on Council's preferred option. I envisage however that Council would prefer that Stanley Road remains in some form of local government ownership. Any management model would need to be considered and approved by Council.
