

DID YOU KNOW?



Plastic water bottles will not begin to break down for 450 years

It takes over 3 litres of water to produce just one plastic water bottle.

The energy saved by recycling one plastic bottle could power a computer for 25 minutes

What can we do?

Reduce: Choose not to use disposable plastic water bottles. When heading out, take a bottle from home and refill it as you need. Aluminium bottles are your best choice, as they can be recycled over and over and over again!

Re-use: When you need to buy a disposable water bottle, re-use it as many times as you can!

Recycle: When you eventually throw out your plastic water bottle, make sure it ends up in your yellow top recycling bin

Recover: If you see a friend throwing away a plastic water bottle, talk to them about reducing, re-using and recycling
