Loose parts are any items that can safely be used for play, eg. crates, boxes, rope, tyres, keyboards, phones and wood.

Loose parts were not originally designed as toys but once they become ‘loose parts’ they have no designed use. This gives children an imaginative opportunity to put every day discarded items to a new use!



Providing an enriched play experience improves fine and gross motor skills, social skills and creativity whilst supporting emotional resilience, physical development, confidence and learning.
