**RE – STANLEY ROAD LANDFILL – SITE CAPPING WORKS FOR LICENCE L8949/2016/11 UNDER THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION ACT 1986**

This letter has been prepared to support the Closure and Post Closure Management Plan (CPCMP) prepared by Talis Consultants Pty Ltd (Talis) on behalf of the Bunbury Harvey Regional Council (Council) to the Department of Environment Regulation (DER) as per IR 2 of Stanley Road Landfill Licence. This letter is to provide guidance on the Councils' long term strategy for Stanley Road including the importance of the Site to service our community in to the future.

The Council has devoted a lot of time, effort and finances towards the capping and proposed future cells in accordance with Best Practice Landfill Guidelines. This will ensure that future development and operations at the Site are in accordance with Best Practice Standards minimising the environmental and social risks associate with such activities. The consultants contracted to provide this works on behalf of Council is Talis, whose team consists of internationally experienced experts in the disciplines of waste management that provide the required knowledge from conceptual through to operational matters for landfills.

The continuation of landfilling at the Councils' Stanley Road Waste Management Facility beyond the current landfill cells airspace is critically important to:

1. Continue to provide waste management services to our communities; and
2. Generate a revenue stream for the final capping of existing cells and ongoing monitoring and reporting requirements as well as any potential liabilities such as significant maintenance works required on the Capping Works.

The construction and operations of the new cells at the landfill will also be suitable to satisfy the waste disposal needs of the Wellington Regional Group of Councils into the future. It is anticipated that the new landfill cell will be operational by the end of 2022. The Council is currently preparing a Works Approval application for the new cells to be submitted to the DER in the coming months.

I trust the submitted CPCMP meets all the Departments requirements and the proposed future cells are met favorably by yourself and the Department of Environment Regulation.
