TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- Competition opening period is from 15/12/2017 – 13/04/2018
- All artwork, including any key features are to be predominantly made from recycled materials
- All group members must be of primary school or high school age in 2018 to enter (year 1 to year 12). To enter the Primary School Category, all group members must be of primary school age in 2018. If a single group member is year 7 or above, the entry will be judged in the High School Age category.
- Entrants must permanently reside in the Council areas of Bunbury, Harvey, Capel, Collie, Dardanup or Donnybrook-Balingup.
- All artwork must be of sound construction, without loose pieces and not negatively affect the surrounding environment
- Entries may be submitted at the below locations provided the length, width or height dimension does not exceed 100cm:
 - Bunbury Library Harvey Library Collie Library
 - Capel Library Donnybrook Library Eaton Library
 - Stanley Road Waste Management Facility
- For any large pieces which have a length, width or height dimension greater than 100cm:
 - Must be weather resistant, as will be exhibited outdoors
 - Cannot be submitted at libraries. Phone 08 9711 1053 for submission instructions
- Bunbury Harvey Regional Council, its education program or its sponsors will not be held liable for any loss, theft or damages to artwork after submission. Any insurance is the responsibility of the entrant.
- The entrant fully releases any images or video taken of the their artwork and themselves at the exhibition for future promotional use
- Adults may assist children with fixing aspects of the work only if it is unsafe for the child to do so unassisted e.g. hot glue gun, welding, screwing. But the placement and remaining work must be that of the child
- Artwork must be collected from Stirling Street Art Centre between 3pm and 5pm on Sunday 13th May 2018. Any artwork uncollected will become the property of the Wellington Regional Waste Education program.
