COVID-19 Current Situation

As Western Australian entered Phase 4 of Covid-19 restrictions late June, BHRC have reviewed current practices and wishes to advise of ongoing arrangements for waste disposal at the Stanley Road Waste Management Facility and the Banksia Road Organics Processing Facility.

Best practices for safely managing waste still remain in place, including assigning responsibility and sufficient human and material resources to dispose of waste safely.

Commercial Waste Disposal – Stanley Road Waste Management Facility

We are continuing to limit access to the weighbridge office but if you would like to collect your ticketing, you may now do so. Two-Way radio communication (Channel 26) is still used for communication if you would like our operator to bring out your weighbridge docket.

Our staff will continue to email your ticket directly to a designated email address if that is your preference. Please advise by email to admin@bhrc.wa.gov.au

Commercial Waste Disposal – Banksia Road Organics Processing Facility

The weighbridge operator will be removed from the Banksia Road Facility, we therefore request that the drivers go back to the usual operation of completing their own ticketing.

Additional Hand Sanitizer and Antibacterial Wipes have been provided.

Transfer Station

Transfer Station clients may be required to dispose of waste without assistance from BHRC staff. Initial contact at the weighbridge office is where any changes to the facility will be communicated.

It is requested at this time, wherever possible that all transactions are cashless.
